**MISSISSIPPI CONSTABLES ASSOCIATION, INC.**  
**CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS**  
Revised June 2024 Convention

**ARTICLE I – ORGANIZATION**

The name of this organization shall be Mississippi Constables Association, Inc., a non-profit association of Constables of the State of Mississippi.

**ARTICLE II – OBJECT OF ORGANIZATION**

The object of this organization shall be to dedicate ourselves to the highest principles, morals, and responsibilities of the office in which we hold. We will strive to upgrade the office of Constable, in all respects. Each elective official shall enforce the laws of the State of Mississippi without fear or favor and equal justice to all. To establish, as far as possible, a uniform system of procedure, costs, fines, and other matters coming before justice courts and to work together for the common good of all Constables. To promote judicial functions and improve public image receive dues, lease or purchase office space or other personal or real property, receive and accept grants from public or private sources that may become available to the Corporation, enter into contracts, pay for services rendered. To the end that these principles may be established, we pledge obedience to the laws of the state and nation and to conduct ourselves in accordance with the moral laws of society and God.

**ARTICLE III – QUALIFICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP**

**SECTION I.** Any Constable of the State of Mississippi who is interested in the objectives of this organization shall be considered for membership.

**SECTION II.** Any prospective member shall be a qualified elected or appointed Constable of Mississippi before they are considered for membership. The interested prospective members shall be presented in writing to the secretary/treasurer.

**SECTION III.** A prospective member must send or pay an annual due (amount to be set by the board of directors) to be a good standing member of the association with voting privileges and other benefits of the association.

## **ARTICLE IV – ASSOCIATE MEMBERS**

**SECTION I.** Any person of good moral character who has been recommended by a dues paid member may pay an annual due (amount to be set by the board of directors) and become an associate member.

**SECTION II.** The associate member will not have any voting privileges in the association.

**SECTION III.** The Secretary/Treasurer will keep a record of all members.

## **ARTICLE V – OFFICERS**

**SECTION I.** The officers of this organization shall be the President, 3 Vice Presidents, Secretary/Treasurer, and a Board of Directors consisting of nine members. Also, a Chaplain and Sergeant-At-Arms will be considered as Board members.

**SECTION II.** The Officers and Board members shall be elected from the floor of the state convention to be held each year in Mississippi in the month designated by the Board of Directors. The President, 3 Vice Presidents, Secretary/Treasurer, Chaplain, and Sergeant-At-Arms must be elected by a majority of the votes. The 3 Board members will be determined by the top 3 vote recipients. If more are nominated than needed, then those with the highest vote shall be seated, provided these represent four from each of the Supreme Court districts. The Officers and Board members will hold their office for one calendar year. The new official will take over their duties at the end of the convention at which they were elected. Any Officer and/or Board member that misses two board meetings without just cause will be replaced by the President.

**SECTION III.** An unexpired term of any Officer or Board member shall be filled by appointment of the President. If the President needs to be removed the Board of Directors will vote to replace him with one of the 3 Vice Presidents.

**SECTION IV.** The officers of the organization shall perform the duties prescribed for them in the parliamentary authority.

**SECTION V.** The out-going President shall remain the Director at Large, with voting privileges, until the current President is replaced.

## **ARTICLE VI – GENERAL INFORMATION**

**SECTION I.** There shall be a state meeting of all members of the association once a year as set by the President and Board of Directors.

**SECTION II.** There shall be a meeting of the officers and Board of Directors in January, April, July and October called by the President with him naming the time and place or a time prescribed by the board. There shall be no business meeting on the Sabbath except in case of emergency.

**SECTION III.** Special meetings may be called by the President or at the request of ten members. In case of an immediate emergency vote, the President may conduct a phone poll of all board members. He is to keep a record of the vote and turn it in to the Secretary/Treasurer.

**SECTION IV.** At regular meetings, members present may transact business by a majority vote. A majority vote of the membership of the association shall be necessary to decide any issue.

## **ARTICLE VII – AMENDMENTS**

**SECTION I.** These by-laws may be amended at any regular meeting of the organization provided that notice was given at a previous meeting or by written notice by the Secretary/Treasurer at the request of the President.

**SECTION II.** The standing rules may be adopted, amended or repealed at any regular meeting by a two-thirds vote.

**SECTION III.** All committees will meet as needed to work out details on given subjects, to report its findings to the Board of Directors to accept or reject their finding. All committees must submit their report to the board before any committee action, with the exception of the jurisprudence, this committee can only be over-ruled by convention assembled.

Requests or motions from the floor related to the expenditure of MCA funds must be reviewed by the finance committee to ensure that the Executive Board has met its fiduciary responsibilities and the requirements for a 501 (c) 6 status as defined by the United States Internal Revenue Law. The Finance Committee will report its findings to the Executive Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting. The Executive Board will then vote to approve or disapprove the expenditure.

**SECTION IV.** The incorporated officers shall be the President or his successors in office; the 3 Vice-Presidents or his successors in office; and the Secretary/Treasurer or his successors in office. The Secretary/Treasurer shall serve as resident agent with his address being the official location of the organization.

## **ARTICLE VIII – COMMITTEES**

**SECTION I.** Committees shall be appointed by the President. There shall be ten committees.

**SECTION II. LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of five members. The chairman shall serve a one-year term and thereafter become vice-chairman. The duty of this committee is to keep the association up-to-date on all legislation that could affect us directly or indirectly, and to push for laws that would upgrade us in our office.

**SECTION III. MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of five members. Their duties shall be to contact all prospective members and organize membership campaigns to recruit members.

**SECTION IV. CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of five members. They shall meet at the request of the President or Board of Directors, or by call from the Constitution By-Laws Chairman. The purpose of this committee is to review the Constitution and By-Laws each year, and to keep them current and up-to-date as to the needs of this organization.

**SECTION V. BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of five members. Their duties are to set up a budget for the coming year and work out plans to raise our finances. This committee will recommend to the Board of Directors to be presented at the convention a yearly budget. All financial programs shall be handled by this committee. The chairman of this committee shall be paid ten percent of gross sales on ads plus an expense budget for the finance chairman. The chairman shall give a written report on all money collected through projects to make revenue the Board of Directors before each convention.

**SECTION VI. GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of five members. They will investigate any wrong that has been committed by persons or members of this association. It shall further be their responsibility to ask for their resignation from office, if the committee feels there is no other way to correct the wrong under investigation. No final action shall be taken by the committee until submitted to the Board of Directors and approved.

**SECTION VII. STATE CONVENTION.** It shall consist of five members. Their duties shall be to make all arrangements and preparation for the state convention.

**SECTION VIII. BENEVOLENCE COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of three members, one from each district. It shall be the duty of these members to send flowers and cards to members that have sickness or death in their immediate family.

**SECTION IX. JURISPRUDENCE.** It shall consist of three members. They shall rule on all legal matters concerning any questions pertaining to the operation or procedure of the association, such as interpretation of the Constitution By-Laws.

**SECTION X. TRAINING COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of three members. They will be appointed by the President with the chairman being the director.

**SECTION XI. AUDIT COMMITTEE.** It shall consist of three members. Their duty is to have a complete audit once per year to be presented to the association at the annual convention.

## **ARTICLE IX**

**SECTION I.** The By-Laws and standing rules shall be read once a year; upon motion and vote of passage from the floor, the by-laws and standing rules may be accepted without change or reading.

**SECTION II.** The Board of Directors shall be the governing body until changed or overruled by the annual convention. The Board of Directors, unless otherwise expressed in the By-Laws, can make any changes.

## **ARTICLE X – DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

**SECTION I. PRESIDENT.** The President shall have general supervision of the association; shall be the presiding officer at state conventions; shall call state meetings of committees when necessary; shall cooperate with all other organizations; shall represent the Association by himself or delegate to meetings of other organizations, when invited; may invite representatives of other organizations to attend meetings of the Association; shall give notice to the Secretary/Treasurer of all state or committee meetings; shall keep all officers informed of all matters needing their attention; shall keep the Vice Presidents advised of all matters relating to business of the Association and office of President. The President shall be an officer of the corporation.

The President shall be allowed a budget expense account as approved by the board. The President shall use said budget for expense while incurred in actual service to the organization. The President will be required to give itemized accounting to the Board of Directors for his expenditures subject to their approval.

**SECTION II. VICE PRESIDENTS.** The Vice Presidents will fulfill the duties of the President in his or her absence; cooperate with the President in their official duties; and serve as program chairman. They will prepare the records and take charge of the organizational activities; report progress of different committees, and shall be an officer of the corporation.

**SECTION III. SECRETARY/TREASURER.** The Secretary/Treasurer shall attend all regular and special meetings and all meetings of the Board of Directors; shall read the minutes before each meeting of the proceeding session; shall serve as the Budget and Finance Chairman; shall receive and receipt all funds coming into state treasury and deposit same in designated depository and pay then out on request of proper officers. The Secretary/Treasurer shall notify the President regarding membership and other association minutes; shall keep all records of state, district, and county members. The Secretary/Treasurer shall be paid a salary of \$250.00 per month. All expenses shall be approved by the President or a member of the board. The Secretary/Treasurer shall be bonded in the amount of \$5000.00 with the bond premium being paid by the Association. The Secretary/Treasurer will have authority to sign vouchers. The Secretary/Treasurer shall be a voting member of the Board of Directors and an officer of the corporation.

**SECTION IV. BOARD OF DIRECTORS.** The Board of Directors shall consist of nine members. They shall attend all state business meetings and such other meetings as shall be necessary; shall promulgate reasonable rules and regulations for the Association to abide by; these rules may be changed or made void by a majority vote of the membership. The President will only vote to break a tie; shall allocate all funds for state purposes as deemed necessary; when any state office shall become vacant, except President, they shall fill such vacancy by appointments until the next general election. The Board of Directors shall have control and management of the property, the organization and the funds. There shall be three Board Members and one Vice President elected from each of the Supreme Court Districts. In the event of a vacancy of President, the Board shall appoint a Vice-President to serve the unexpired term. There must be a Board of Director's meeting immediately preceding the convention.

# RULES OF JUSTICE COURT

## RULE 14 SERVICE OF PROCESS

**(a) Service of process defined.** Service of process for civil actions in justice court means serving a true copy of the summons and complaint upon the defendant in accordance with this rule.

**(b) Issuance of summons and form.** Summons shall be issued by the justice court clerk. Any summons issued under this rule shall name the court and the parties; be directed to the defendant; state the name and address of the plaintiff's attorney or, if unrepresented, of the plaintiff; state the date and time within which the defendant must appear and defend; notify the defendant that a failure to appear and defend may result in a default judgment against the defendant for the relief demanded in the complaint; be signed and dated by the justice court clerk; and bear the court's seal.

**(c) SERVICE BY CONSTABLE.** Upon the filing of the complaint, the justice court clerk shall promptly deliver a true copy of the summons and complaint to the constable of the county of the defendant's usual place of abode or, if the defendant is an entity, to the constable of the county of the entity's place of business, to serve process upon the defendant. Within ten (10) days thereafter, unless service has been waived, the constable shall file an affidavit showing proof of service, or of attempted service after diligent search and inquiry pursuant to section 25-7-27 of the Mississippi Code, with the justice court clerk.

**(d) Manner of service upon an individual.** (1) Personal service. The constable shall deliver a true copy of the summons and complaint to the defendant or to an agent authorized by appointment or by law to receive process. Service shall be deemed complete upon the date of service. (2) Service upon a family member. If service under paragraph (d)(1) cannot be made with reasonable diligence, then the constable shall deliver a true copy of the summons and complaint at the defendant's usual place of abode with the defendant's spouse or some other person of the defendant's family above the age of sixteen (16) years, and within three (3) days thereafter, by mailing a true copy of the summons and complaint, by first class mail, postage prepaid, to the defendant at the address where the true copy of the summons and complaint were properly delivered. Service shall be deemed complete on the 10th day after the mailing. (3) Service by posting. If service under paragraphs (d)(1) and (d)(2) cannot be made with reasonable diligence, then the constable shall serve process by posting a true copy of the summons and complaint on a door of the defendant's usual place of abode that is reasonably calculated to provide notice of the action and, within three (3) days thereafter, by mailing a true copy of the summons and complaint, by first class mail, postage prepaid, to the defendant at the address where the true copy of the summons and complaint was posted. Service shall be deemed complete on the 10th day after the mailing.

**(e) Manner of service upon all others.** The constable shall serve process in the manner provided by Rule 4 of the Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure for mentally incompetent persons or entities located in the state.

**(f) SERVICE BY SHERIFF.** When any process has not been returned by the constable as required by this rule, then the justice court clerk may direct the sheriff of the county of the defendant's usual place of abode or, if the defendant is an entity, to the sheriff of the county of the entity's place of business, to serve process upon the defendant in like manner as required of a constable under this rule. **(g) SERVICE BY PROCESS SERVER.** When any process has not been returned by the constable as required by this rule, the plaintiff may make a written request for service by a process server. Upon receiving a written request, the justice court clerk shall promptly deliver a true copy of the summons and complaint to the plaintiff or the plaintiff's attorney for service of process by a process server in like manner as required of a constable under this rule. The process server must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and not be a party to the action.

## RULES OF JUSTICE COURT

**(h) Service by certified mail, return receipt requested, upon persons or entities located outside the state.**

When the defendant is a person or entity located outside the state, the plaintiff may make a written request for service by certified mail, return receipt requested. Upon receiving a written request, the justice court clerk shall promptly deliver a true copy of the summons and complaint to the plaintiff or the plaintiff's attorney for service of process by certified mail, return receipt requested. Within twenty (20) days thereafter, the sender shall file with the justice court clerk the return receipt or the return envelope marked "Refused." Where the defendant is a natural person, the envelope shall be marked "Restricted Delivery." Service of process by this method shall be deemed complete from the date of delivery as evidenced by the return receipt or the return envelope marked "Refused."

**(I) Service upon multiple defendants.** If there are multiple defendants, then a separate true copy of the summons and complaint shall be served on each defendant named in the action.

**(j) Validity of service.** Nothing in this rule shall invalidate any service of process for being made untimely or for an untimely filed return.

**(k) Waiver.** Any defendant who is not a mentally incompetent person may waive the service of process or enter an appearance, with the effect of being duly served with lawful process, in the manner provided under Rule 4(e) of the Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure.

**(l) Amendment.** The justice court judge may allow any service of process or proof of service under this rule to be amended for good cause shown, unless it clearly appears that material prejudice would result to the substantial rights of the defendant.

**(m) Time limit for service.** The justice court judge may dismiss without prejudice any action where, without good cause, it appears from the court file that service of process has not been made upon the defendant within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the filing of the complaint. A party may file a motion for enlargement of time any time prior to a dismissal by the court.

**(n) Fees for service of process.**

(1) By constable. Service of process by the constable may be taxed as court costs for an amount not exceeding the statutory amount allowed by law. No fees for service shall be paid to a constable who has neither served nor attempted to serve process in substantial compliance to this rule.

(2) By sheriff. Service of process by the sheriff may be taxed as court costs for an amount not exceeding the statutory amount allowed by law. No fees for service shall be paid to a sheriff who has neither served nor attempted to serve process in substantial compliance to this rule.

(3) By process server. Service of process by a process server may be taxed as court costs for an amount not exceeding the statutory amount allowed by law to the constable for service of process. 10 (4) By certified mail, return receipt requested. Service of process by certified mail, return receipt requested, on a person or entity located outside the state may be taxed as court costs for an amount not exceeding the amount of postage for the mailing.

# The Constable's Heritage

## A Proud Tradition of Service

The word "constable" comes to us from the Latin, "come stabuli," the "head of the stables at the imperial court." The first men to perform the role of constable were special, trusted men who guarded the royal stable and armaments.

In ancient Rome order was kept by a select group of men chosen for their courage and good judgement. They were the first organized group to perform the functions that we have come to associate with the constable.

In feudal times the office of Constable was a high military rank. The constable was the highest militia rank and decided on all questions of chivalry and honor.

The constable was introduced into British Common Law following the Norman invasion of 1066 A.D. Originally his job was to keep the militia and the king's armaments in a state of preparedness to defend the village communities throughout England. The Constable was the representative of the King in all military affairs. In France the Constable was one of the five great offices, taking precedence immediately after the King himself.

The Blackstone Commentaries on the Common Law provide for a broad range of Constable duties and powers. Only the most responsible and competent of men could be considered for the position of Constable. Constables were entrusted with collecting taxes, arresting lawbreakers, conducting searches, transporting prisoners, and serving all criminal and civil papers. Even the local drugstore had to open its books and records to the Constable.

The Constable was the first law enforcement officer in the new American colonies. While he sprang from uniquely English roots, his American growth was far ranging and diverse. The Constable's duties varied from place to place according to the needs of the people he served. The Constable was the sealer of weights and measures. He surveyed lands, announced marriages, and executed all warrants. The Constable meted out physical punishment and generally kept the peace.

The first American constable with these powers was Joshua Pratt in Plymouth colony in 1634. While many of the duties were delegated to other officials, in general the constable was responsible for the "Watch and Ward," the Ward during the day, and the Watch during the night. The New England settlers went as far as to appoint Indian constables, each holding office for a year and responsible for overseeing the nine other Indians under his command.

Today the office of Constable has evolved in many forms. In some places he is appointed, in others he is elected. His powers vary from simply the service of process to those of policemen and sheriff.

Generally, constables work on a fee plus mileage basis, with the fee paid by the wrongdoer, not the taxpayer. Constables are available for a variety of assignments for the judicial and executive branches of government. They serve criminal and civil process, transport prisoners, collect back taxes and debts owed the government, and provide a trained, professional manpower pool ready to serve in times of emergency on a twenty-four hour a day basis, all at no cost to the taxpayer. All other law enforcement officers owe their status to the Constable and can trace their own history back to the heritage of the Constable.

It is this proud tradition of service and responsibility that makes today's professional constable a vital, much needed component of the delivery of the justice system.

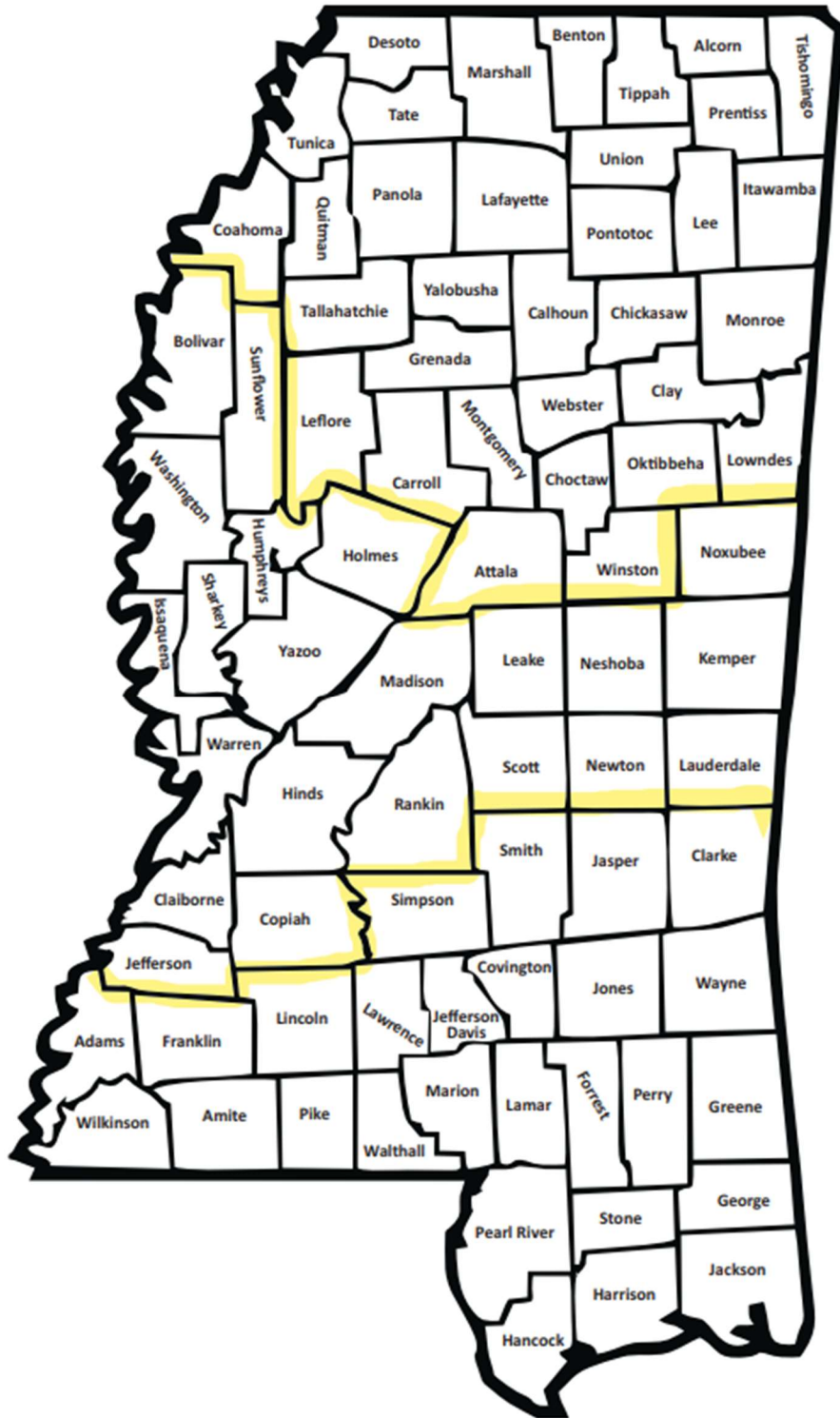

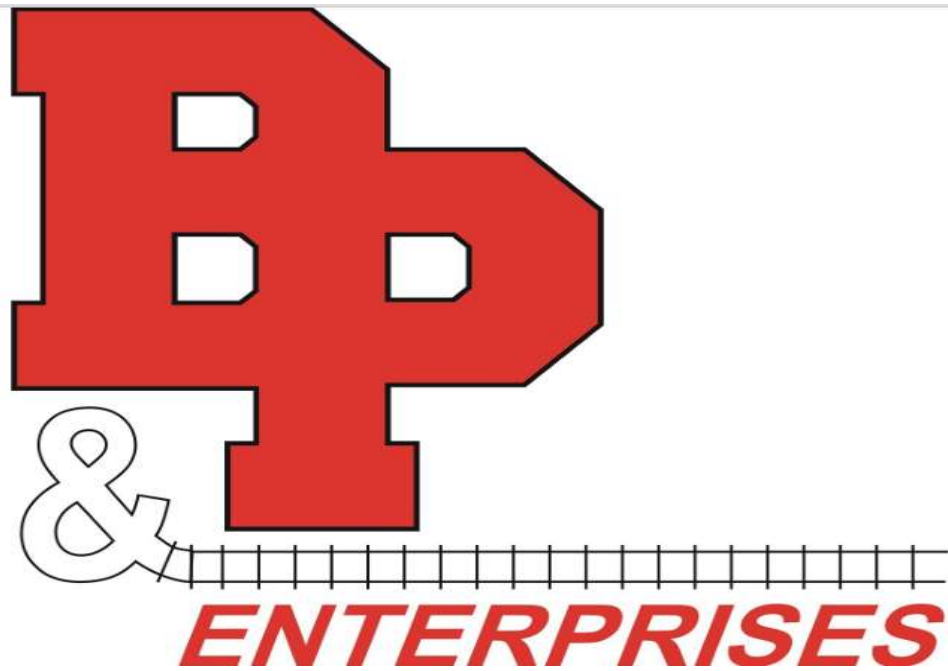

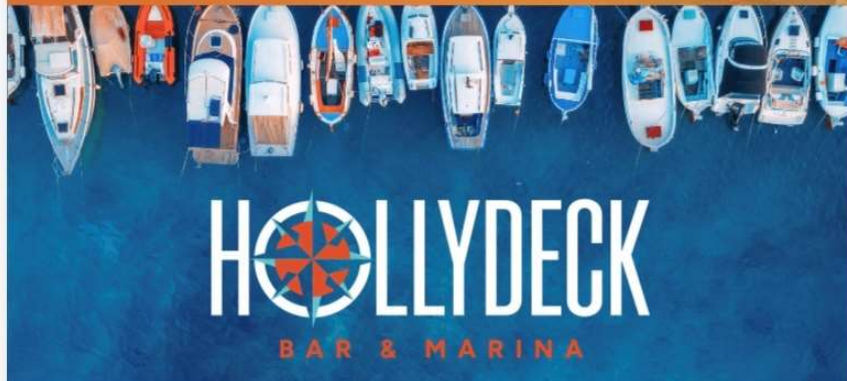
